



We want to make it easy for you to bring a group!

Group discounts on tickets—Get a \$5 discount on each ticket when you place your group's ticket order together. It's already built into the Weinberg Center's online ticketing system!

Bus and large van unloading area—You're coming into the heart of downtown Frederick when you come to the Weinberg Center. Since the show is during the day, the planning committee has reserved parallel parking spots on the right side of W. Patrick Street so that busses and large vans can easily and safely unload. Since the Weinberg's on the left side of W. Patrick Street, which is a one-way street, we'll have crossing guards on hand to help everyone cross the street to the Weinberg safely.

Parking—There are 5 parking garages in downtown Frederick, all are within walking distance of the Weinberg Center. www.ParkFrederick.org is a great resource! The Court Street Parking Deck is immediately behind the theater (GPS address is 2 S. Court Street, Frederick, MD 21701). And, the West Patrick Street Deck is in the block past the Weinberg Center (GPS address is 138 W. Patrick Street, Frederick, MD 21701). Full-size cars, SUVs, trucks, and minivans all fit in the parking garages in downtown Frederick.

Parking for Busses and Oversized Passenger Vans—Free parking for busses and oversized vans is available just outside of downtown Frederick.

- There's a Wal-Mart closeby (7400 Guilford, Dr., Frederick, MD 21704) that has fast food and other shops adjacent.
- The FSK Mall is a little further away, but offers lots of options for the driver while s/he waits.
- There is also parking available at Harry Grove Stadium (our Frederick Keys minor league ballpark), which is very close to the theater.
- **Special note:** The planning committee can work with you if you are renting a passenger van, need to park it for the day, and the van driver is also attending Vu Le's presentation. A quick shuttle ride can be arranged for the driver to get back to the theater. Let us know in advance by reaching out to [Jen Specht](#).
